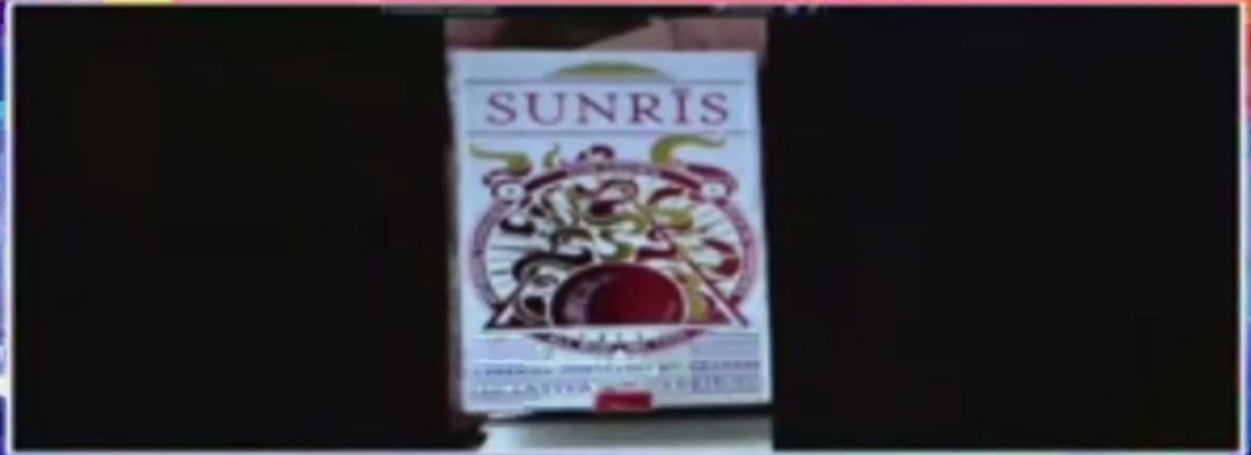

Operation and Team:-

On the basis of specific information, NCB Mumbai effected a seizure of Ganja from one courier at Bandra West. In the follow-up operation huge stash of imported strains of Ganja was recovered from a resident of Jaswant Heights Khar west named Karan Sajnani (British National). Further on revelation of Karan Sajnani Ganja and Bud was recovered from Rahila Furniturewala who is also suspect in the investigation of Cr. No. 16/2020 of Mumbai Zonal Unit. Karan Sajnani and was marketed to high class clients in Mumbai and various other states. The smuggling activity was supported by Rahila Furniturewala by providing financial and other aids.

Details of Recoveries and arrested persons:

Total contraband seized was approximately 200 kg. Two Indian nationals and one British National have been arrested. Further follow up action is underway.

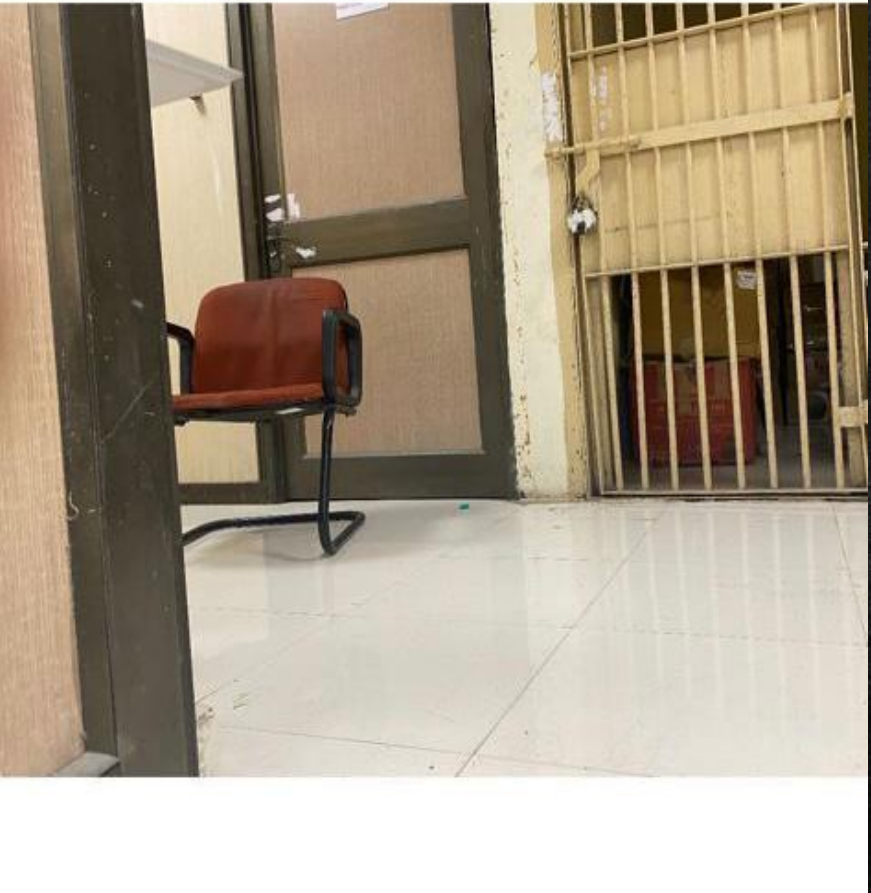

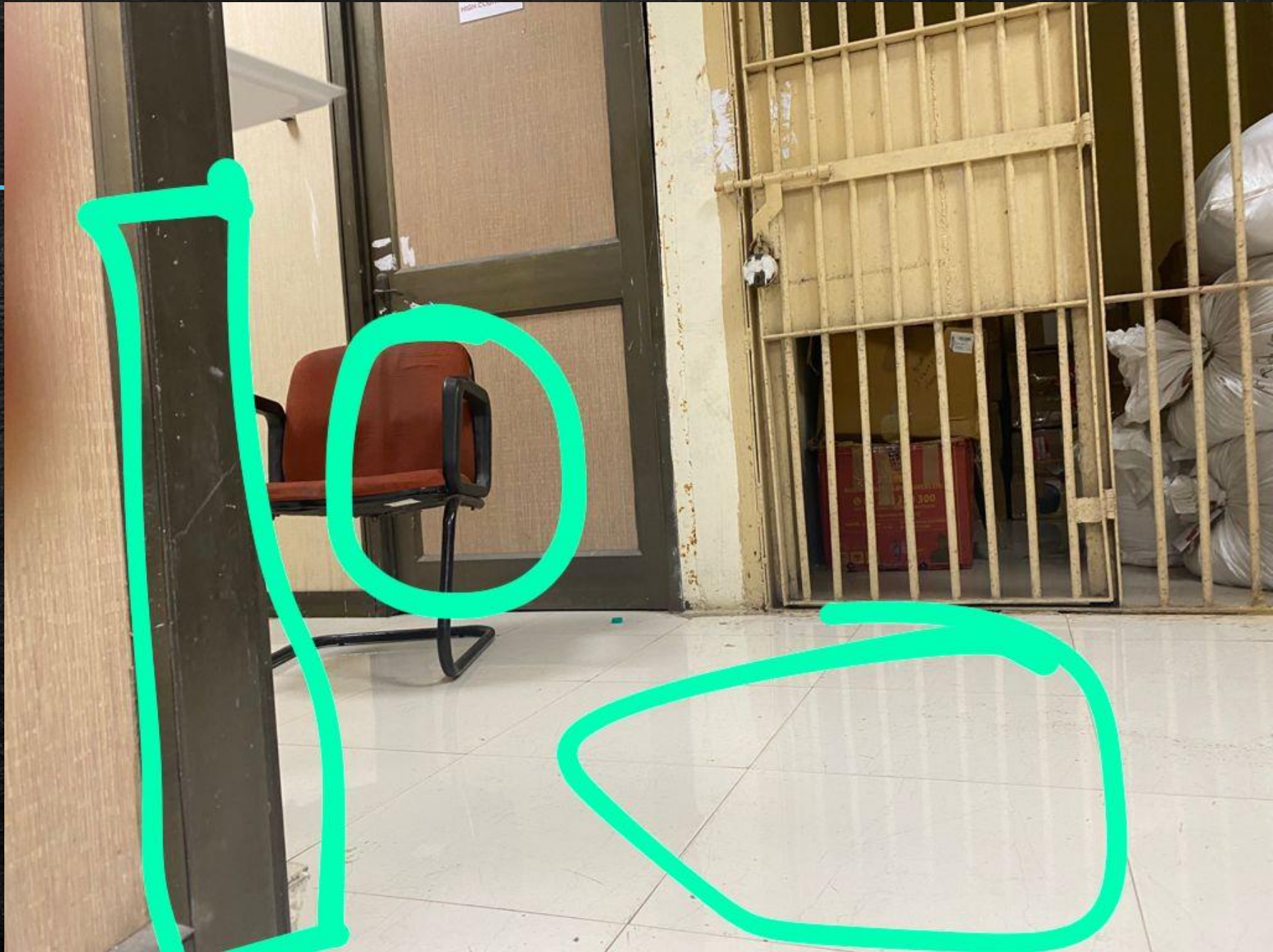

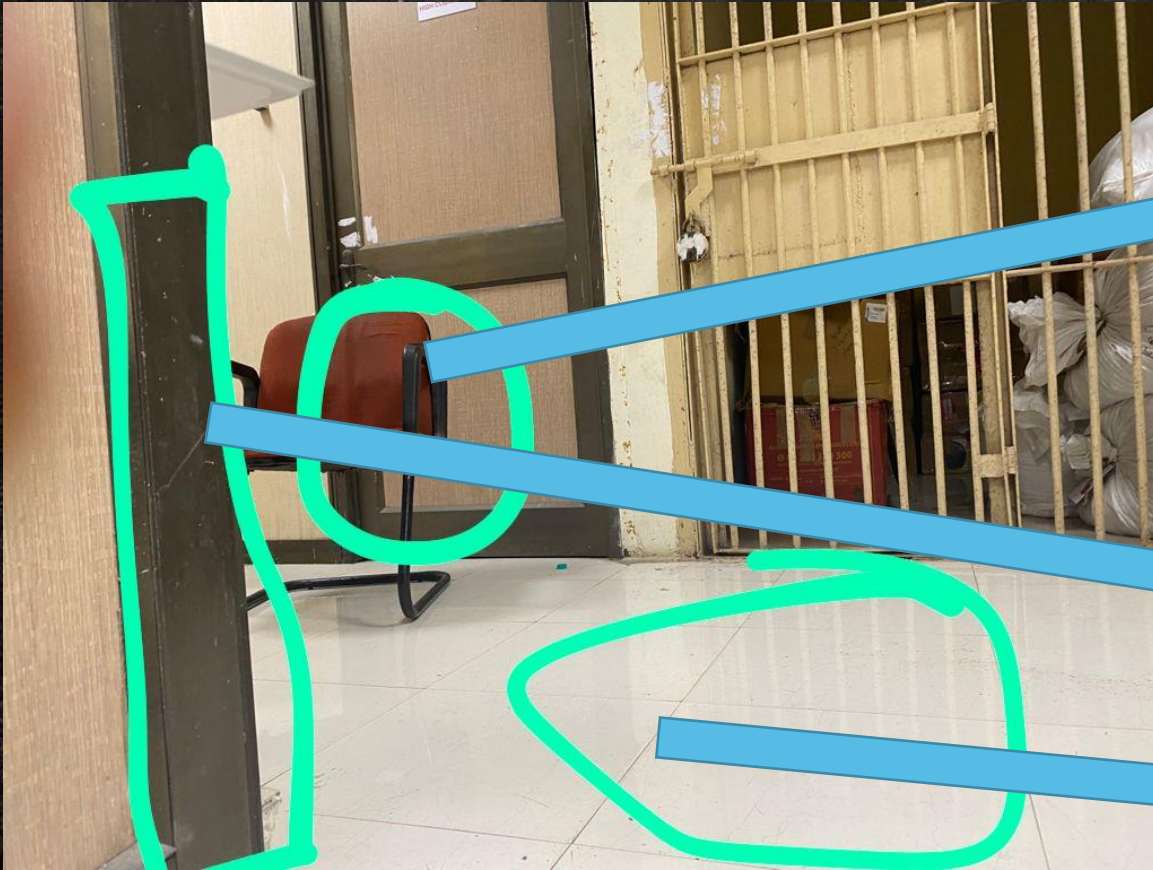

REPLY TO THE APPLICATION EXHIBIT IN BA NO.611 OF 2021

MAY IT PLEASE YOUR HONOUR -

It is submitted in behalf of prosecution that

- a) The application is devoid of merits and reserves to be rejected outright.
- b) The photographs annex to the application clearly shows that the location where the articles were seen; and photographed is clicked is not mentioned anywhere and not seen in any of the photograph.
- c) It is false to say that it was clicked in the office of the NCB without strict proof thereof.
- d) The photograph does not show or anything to show it was clicked in the NCB Office.
- e) None of the officers is seen showing those articles in open conditions.
- f) The top lines of first photograph mention about "NCB Raids" in two locations in Mumbai, 200kg of drug seized, 03 arrested", in this case raids were conducted at three different places and not two, therefore photograph cannot be connected in this case.

g) It is denied that the press was briefed and shown the articles in the NCB Office, therefore there is no question arises for consideration about clicking the photographs.

h) Being a sensitive case it is possible that the press was following respective teams, at following perspective location. It is possible that they might have entered the premises searched and clicked the photographs during the course of panchnama and sealing those articles and might have flashed in the news telecast.

i) The application is violation of section 80 of Evidence Act: which lays down the procedure to prove the article publish to media and newspaper, this can only be done after examination of concerned photographs, editor, publisher, on oath before the court; then only such report is admissible evidence and admissible in law.

j) The application is to misguide and malign the Image of prosecution Agency and to mislead before the court with intention to adversely affect the mind of court, against prosecution; and about the fair justice.

Therefore, it is prayed that application be rejected and photograph be discarded even from the purpose of looking into it as same were produced without following the process of law.

13. Another crucial fact brought to the notice of the court with regard to the panchnama being held at the Rampur, Uttar Pradesh. The complaint shows for the alleged contraband at the time of seizure to be of 194.600 kgs, but the panchnama held at Rampur, Uttar Pradesh which is not accompanied with the charge sheet mentions for the quantum of contraband to be 189 kgs. This particular aspect propagates for the conduct of the investigating machinery and the reason for not incorporating the said panchnama is till date is not answered. It is also alleged by the Ld. Advocate for the applicant/accused that, the panchnama at Rampur, Uttar Pradesh and the other panchnamas contradict each other, thereby evolving the theory of false implications. This particular aspect has to be adjudicated at the stage of trial.

14. As regards invoking of section 27A and 29 of the NDPS Act, it is evident that factum of conspiracy and abetment as alleged by the prosecution there is connivance between the either accused. The reply filed by the respondent categorically mentions for the fact that as the contraband recovered is in commercial quantity and even by virtue of section 29 the complicity of the present applicant is made out and therefore rigors of section 37 are attracted. It is pertinent that the applicant accused has already stated that he conducts such business pertaining to nicotine products. Now considering the fact that the CA report has specifically enumerated the contraband material to 11 samples to have not detected for cannabis the theory of the prosecution

with regard to the invoking of section 29 fails and apart from the said contention in the reply nothing is brought on record to show the factum of connivance with each other or that of conspiracy in *prima-facie*. Thereafter as stated by the Ld. advocate for applicant/accused it is evident that when the C.A. report relied by the prosecution is negative no charge under section 27 A can be sustained.

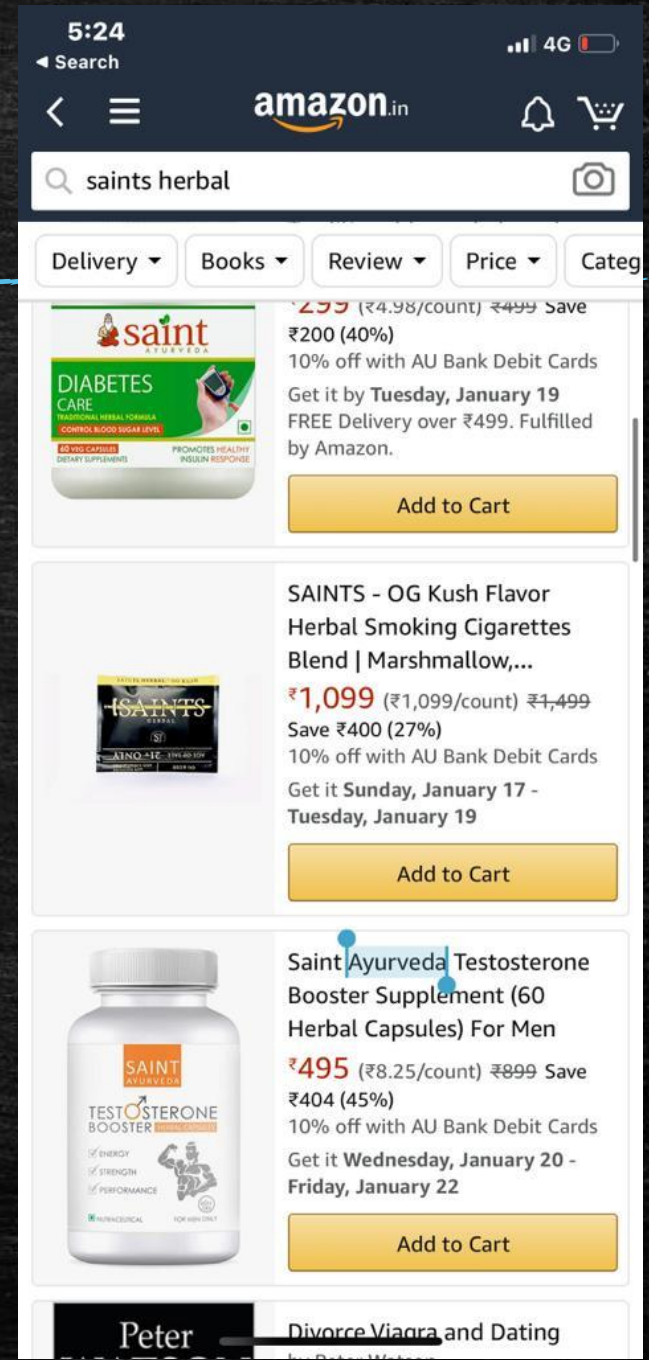
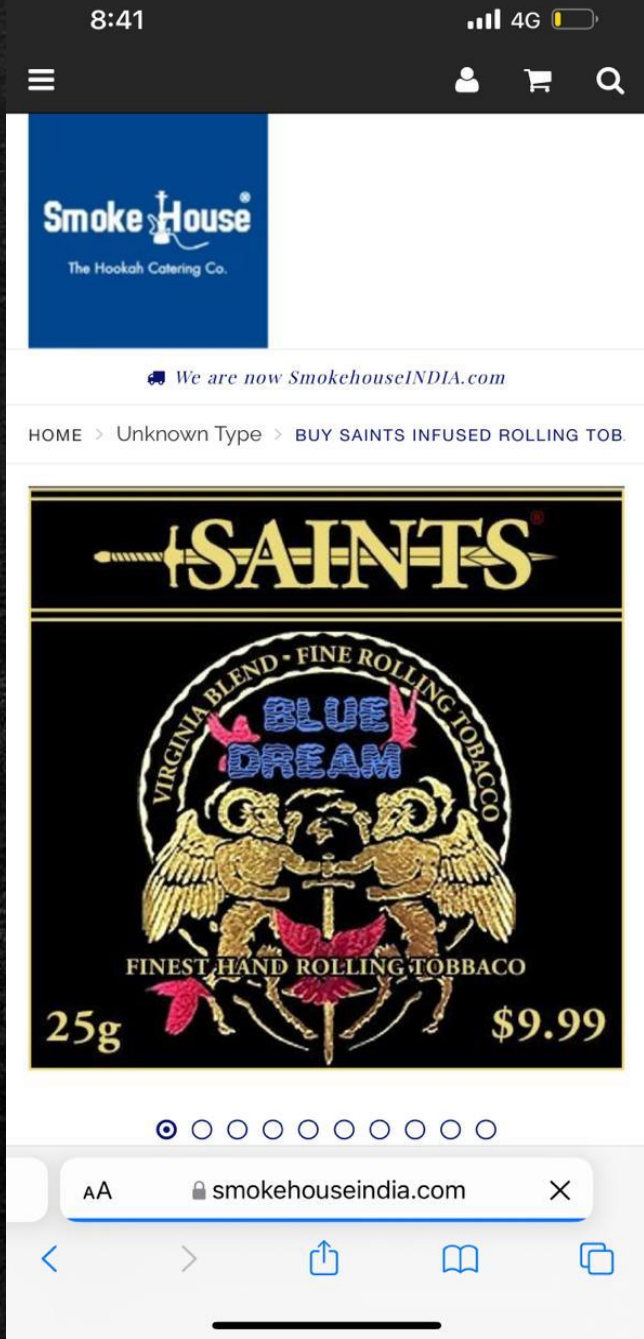

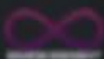
